

2012 Motorcycle Sportsmen Club Classes(Southern Downs Championship)

Formula 1

Formula Unlimited - Solo Machines 750cc to 1300cc, competitors may choose their own slick or treaded tyres.

Superstock 1000 – As per 2012 Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 15.9, tyres must be manufactured for road use only. (No Slicks)

Formula 2

Supersport - As per Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 15.7 with the exception that competitors may choose their own slick or treaded tyres.

Superstock – As per 2012 Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 15.8, tyres must be manufactured for road use (No Slicks) as per 2012 MOM Rule 15.8.0.2.

250GP – Up to 250cc, two stroke GP machines

Formula 3

Up to 250cc Production Based machines

Up to 400cc multi cylinder four stroke machines

Up to 650cc four stroke twin cylinder machines

Supermono – Up to 750cc single cylinder machines mounted in road based chassis.

125GP & 250GP Mono – As per the 2012 Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 15.12 and 15.13.

Formula 4

Classic – Machines manufactured prior to 31st Dec 1962 as per 2012 MOM Chapter 16.

Post Classic Up to 500cc - Machines up to 500cc manufactured between 1st Jan 1963 and 31st Dec 1972 as per 2012 MOM Chapter 16.

Forgotten Era Up to 500cc – Machines up to 500cc manufactured between 1st Jan 1973 and 31st Dec 1982 as per 2012 MOM Chapter 16.

New Era Up to 500cc - Machines up to 500cc manufactured between 1st Jan 1983 and 31st Dec 1990 as per 2012 MOM Chapter 16.

Lites – Up to 100cc 2 stroke and Up to 150cc 4 stroke, air cooled machines.

Formula 5

Sidecars - Formula 1, Formula 2, Post Classic and Classic Sidecars as per 2012 Manual of Motorcycle Sport rules.

Formula 6

Post Classic Unlimited - Machines manufactured between 1st Jan 1963 and 31st Dec 1972 as per 2012 MOM Chapter 16.

Forgotten Era Unlimited - Machines manufactured between 1st Jan 1973 and 31st Dec 1982 as per 2012 MOM Chapter 16.

New Era 526cc to 1300cc - Machines manufactured between 1st Jan 1983 and 31st Dec 1990 as per 2012 MOM Chapter 16.

Pre Modern Unlimited – Machines manufactured between 1st Jan 1991 and 31st Dec 1995.

Supermotos – As per 2012 Manual of Motorcycle Sport Chapter 24.

Junior 70, 80 and 160 – As per 2012 Manual of Motorcycle Sport Rule 15.17.

Rookie Class – Unlimited capacity, open to competitors who have not raced previously or who have not raced for a number of years. Competitors are accepted at the discretion of the Clerk of Course and the Motorcycle Sportsmen. Maximum of 4 meetings in this class.
