What you get?

- By taking part in the “National come and try day” participants who have never held a Motorcycling Australia License will be eligible to apply for a half price Senior National License (Race license) or a free Recreational License (valid for track days and coaching days), both license are valid for one year.
- Race bikes will be on show, so you can learn exactly what is required to make your bike race ready.
- Coaches and racers will be on hand if you have any questions.

How to take part

- To take part in the “National come and try day” with the Motorcycle Sportsmen you will need to hold a current Motorcycle Road license as proof of riding competency.
- Turn up anytime between 8am and midday on Sunday the 23rd of February.
- Bring your Australian Drivers License with R or RE competency.
