Queensland Champions crowned.

Queensland's two premier motorcycle road racing Championships have been decided in thrilling contests.

WARWICK – The state's finest road racers converged on Morgan Park Raceway across the weekend of August 2nd and 3rd to contest the second and final round of the 2014 Pirelli QLD Road Race Championship for Superbike and Supersport classes.

Fine weather and strong fields of riders were two hallmarks of the meeting, as Queensland's most powerful road racing motorcycles battled for points and Championship glory.

In the blue ribbon Superbike class, Brett Kitchin (BMW S1000RR) put on an impressive display, taking a clean sweep of wins across the weekend's four races. Undefeated throughout the series, Kitchin deservedly won the title with a perfect score of 200 points. Nicholas Hull (Aprilia RSV4) and Phillip Foster (Aprilia RSV4) thrilled the crowds, battling all weekend for the remaining two places on the Championship rostrum, with Hull besting Foster by just two points in the final tally.

The Supersport class had spectators on the edges of their seats with exciting, close racing. The final Championship points tally saw a gap of only seven points separating the top three place-getters. Tony Blair (Honda CBR600RR) consolidated his clean-sweep of Round One earlier in the year with solid results in Round Two to earn the title, edging out Harrison Cox (Yamaha R6) by four points, with Steven Relph (Yamaha R6) only another three points adrift in 3rd place for the year.
